Two Deadlines:

#1 December 4, 2016 Projects dealing with:

human subjects (surveys, mental/physical tests)

microbes (bacteria, fungi, rDNA, human or vertebrate tissues/bodily fluids, cell lines)

vertebrate animals or DEA controlled substances, lab grade chemicals potentially unsafe devices or activities.

*Note the earlier deadline is because these subjects require the fair's safety review of procedure and materials before experimentation can begin.

#2 January 30, 2017 All other types of projects. (such as robotics, bioinformatics, computer science, engineering, environmental studies, etc.)
